A Legacy Of Care: Reflecting On 30 Years Of Abha Surgy Centre

Dear Readers,

Thirty-two years ago, I faced a life-altering choice: to remain in London, where I had an established gynaecological practice and a thriving career, or to return to my hometown of Kolkata, where my skills could serve a community in need but where no one knew me. Choosing to come back to Kolkata shaped my life in ways I could never have imagined.

When I returned, fate led me to Dr. Konkon, my life partner and greatest collaborator. Together, we dreamt of creating a sanctuary for women's reproductive health—a place where compassion, expertise, accessibility were the guiding principles. With no entrepreneurial background and limited resources, the vision felt ambitious, but our determination was unwavering. Today, 30 years, over 100,000 surgeries, and countless success stories later, I can say with confidence that it was the best decision of my life.

The day we opened Abha Surgy Centre is a memory I cherish deeply. Our beginnings were humble—a small clinic in my grandfather's old residence, where we repurposed rooms into consultation areas. Much of our equipment was second-hand or gifted by my generous father-in-law, Dr. K.K. Das. Patients came slowly at first, often

with scepticism about our ability to make an impact. But what we lacked in resources, we made up for with belief in our vision and the desire to serve.

One memory from those early days remains etched in my heart. A couple walked into our clinic, burdened by years of heartbreak, societal judgment, and dwindling finances. They had endured repeated disappointments and were told by numerous doctors that parenthood was beyond their reach. After extensive consultations, we discovered significant medical challenges: uterine scarring and a low sperm count, making their case exceptionally complex. Despite the odds, they placed their last hopes in us.

We crafted a tailored treatment plan, combining IVF with advanced interventions. It was a journey fraught with anxious days and multiple procedures, but they persevered. Months later, I carried their tiny miracle out of the operation theatre. As I placed the baby in their arms, the husband broke down in tears—his emotions a mix of gratitude, relief, and the realization that their long-held dream had come true. That moment reaffirmed why Abha Surgy Centre exists—not just to treat medical conditions, but to restore hope where it feels impossible.

Abha Surgy Centre was built on more than just medical expertise; it was grounded in values passed down by two extraordinary individuals: my father-in-law, Dr. Das, and my mentor, Dr. Baidyanath Chakraborty. Dr. Chakraborty's advice, "Focus on providing affordable care, and success will follow," became the cornerstone of our philosophy. This ethos continues to guide us today, as we provide many treatments free of charge each year to couples in need.

Our journey has not been without challenges. IVF was a novel concept in India at the time, and scepticism ran deep. I spent many sleepless nights drafting brochures to educate people about the procedure, hoping to demystify it. Slowly but surely, awareness grew, and as patients began sharing their success stories, Abha earned its place as a trusted centre for women's healthcare.

What makes this journey truly fulfilling is the multigenerational trust we've

built. Patients who came to us for infertility treatments decades ago now bring their daughters to Abha for gynaecological care. These relationships, built on faith and shared milestones, make Abha more than a clinic—it's a part of their family stories.

Our team has been integral to this journey, embodying the values that define Abha. I am particularly moved by the story of a young science graduate who joined us in our early days. Konkon mentored her in embryology, and over time, she became one of our most accomplished team members. Today, her daughter has joined our team, carrying forward the legacy of care and excellence. It's moments like these that highlight the spirit of continuity and belonging that make Abha unique.

Over the years, we've expanded our scope to include high-risk obstetrics, male infertility, genetic counselling, and mental health. I'm reminded of a recent case involving a couple who were both thalassemia carriers. Helping them navigate the complexities of genetic counselling and conceive a healthy child reinforced our mission: to create hope where it feels like none exists.

As we celebrate 30 years of Abha, I am overwhelmed with gratitude—for the families who placed their trust in us, the patients who became part of our journey, and the team members who turned our vision into reality. Every patient who walks through our doors leaves a mark on our story, and I am humbled to have been a part of theirs.

Looking ahead, we are excited to expand our facilities and extend our footprint across Kolkata and beyond. While our services will grow, the heart of Abha will always remain the same: affordable, compassionate, and patient-centred care.

To every patient, team member, and well-wisher who has been a part of this incredible journey—thank you. Here's to 30 years of transforming lives and to many more to come.

Launch Of Abha Surgy Centre's Special Cover With Stamp



To celebrate the 30th anniversary of Abha Surgy Centre, the leading IVF and Gynaecology clinic of Eastern India, India Post released a Special Cover and Stamp to commemorate the occasion. This marks three decades of the clinic's success in helping couples achieve parenthood.

The Special Cover and Stamp was launched by Mr Ashok Kumar, the Postmaster General of Kolkata Region in the presence of Dr Basudeb Mukherjee, Senior Gynaecologist associated with Ankuran IVF Clinic, Woodlands Hospital, and Manipal Hospital, Dr Bani Kumar Mitra, the Founder & Chief Consultant of Abha Surgy Centre and Dr Konkon Das Mitra, Director and Chief Embryologist of Abha Surgy Centre.

The Special Cover and Stamp underscored in a unique way, to the clinic's three decades of contributions to women's healthcare and IVF services, making it a memorable occasion for the centre and its patrons.









Indian Stamp History:

- 1. The very first stamp in India was released in 1852.
- 2. It had a circular shape and was called Scinde Dawke.
- 3. The entire print-run was individually embossed on paper.
- 4. The first stamp of Independent India was issued on 21 November 1947 and was valued at 3 ½ annas. It depicted the Indian National Flag and the slogan, Jai Hind.
- 5. The old inscription of 'INDIA POSTAGE' was removed and replaced in 1962 with 'भारत INDIA' that has continued till today. However, three stamps issued between December 1962 to January, 1963 still carried the earlier inscription. There is no records of whether they are still around anywhere!
- 6. Today, India has the most widely distributed postal system in the world followed by China.





A Journey Worth Looking Back

Becoming a doctor was more than a career choice for me—it was a legacy I was destined to carry forward. I come from a family of doctors spanning four generations on my paternal side, and my father, Dr. K.K. Das, a renowned obstetrician- gynecologist in Bokaro, played a pivotal role in shaping my path. Watching him serve his patients with unwavering dedication left an indelible mark on me, instilling in me a deep sense of purpose and compassion for others.

Life has a way of weaving beautiful stories, and mine unfolded further during my training when I met Dr. Bani Kumar Mitra at the hospital where we worked. What began as a professional connection blossomed into a love story. Our shared passion for medicine and commitment to improving women's health brought us closer, not just as partners in life but as collaborators in our dream of creating a healthcare facility that would truly make a difference. Marrying Dr. Mitra was the start of a journey that would ultimately bring our personal and professional lives full circle.

In 1998, with this vision firmly in mind, I left for the National University Hospital in Singapore to train in embryology. IVF was still in its early stages in India, and my father, ever the visionary, encouraged me to embrace this opportunity. It was not an easy decision—I left hehind four-year-old daughter to pursue this specialized training. But I knew that equipping myself with the knowledge and skills of this emerging field would allow me to contribute meaningfully to countless families longing for a child.

Upon returning to India, we laid the foundation for Abha Surgy Centre. IVF was a nascent field then, and I consider myself fortunate to have been among the first doctors in India trained in embryology. Building this practice was not just about implementing new techniques but also about nurturing a team. I took pride in mentoring young science graduates, many of whom remain with us to this day, forming the backbone of our operations.

The early days of Abha were humble yet determined. We operated out of my late grandfather's residence, repurposing rooms to meet our needs. The living room became the waiting area, the kitchen transformed into a darkroom for developing USG films, and bedrooms served as consultation and treatment spaces. With no paid marketing, we relied on the trust and goodwill of our first patients. Slowly steadily, word-of-mouth recommendations began to bring in more families, and the clinic's reputation grew.

As the patient base expanded, so did our facilities. We acquired properties close to the original clinic, ensuring we avoided high rental costs, which allowed us to keep our fees affordable. Staying true to Dr. Mitra's principle that no patient should walk away due to financial constraints, we remained focused on offering quality care at reasonable rates.

Over the years, Abha Surgy Centre has evolved into a trusted institution, expanding our services far beyond gynecology and fertility. Today, we are proud to offer high-risk obstetrics, male infertility treatments, psychological counseling, obesity management, PCO clinics, mental health support, and endoscopic Patients surgery. travel neighboring countries like Bangladesh to seek our care, and many choose to bring their children into the world at Abha.

What makes IVF particularly special to me is its inherently collaborative nature. Every member of our team, from embryologists to janitors, plays an indispensable role in ensuring success. IVF is a procedure that demands precision, cleanliness, and teamwork, and I am deeply grateful for the incredible team that has stood by us through every challenge.

As I reflect on this journey, I feel a profound sense of pride and gratitude. From a modest clinic housed in my grandfather's home to the multi-specialty center it is today, Abha Surgy Centre stands as a testament to perseverance, innovation, and the unwavering belief in making healthcare accessible.

Looking ahead, I am excited about the opportunities the future holds. We remain committed to providing compassionate, high-quality care for every patient who walks through our doors, driven by the same purpose and passion that laid the foundation of Abha all those years ago.

I was about five years old when I first witnessed the impact of my father's work. We were enjoying phuchka on a busy street in Kolkata when a couple approached us. Their toddler wobbled beside them, a living testament to my father's dedication. That moment illuminated why my father often missed dinner at home—it was his calling to help families grow.

As I matured, my summers were spent at Abha Surgy, our old house turned clinic, nestled in the heart of our community. Emphasized the evolution of IVF from treating tubal blockages to addressing infertility. He explained the four key steps in IVF and how modifications are tailored for individual cases, maximizing success rates while minimizing costs. Dr Mitra explained how it is important to understand that there are modifications of these four basic steps from case to case to ensure successful IVF. As medical technologies evolve by the day, doctors try and incorporate the latest method to enable greater success at a reduced cost. For instance, nowadays, doctors try to deliver a single baby as against twin babies in IVF to maximize the chance of success, eliminate the health complications associated with the latter and also provide cost relief to the couple at the same time.

Shared how societal views on IVF have transformed. From initial skepticism to acceptance, Roy highlighted the growing embrace of IVF, especially among single women who choose motherhood. Some forward-thinking individuals have gone right ahead and embraced change in all areas but unfortunately, there are some who prefer to "stick in the mud". She said she had several friends who were never interested in matrimony but keen to experience motherhood. Her film Ekla Cholo, which tackled IVF, was well-received, marking a cultural shift in attitudes. The plot takes the viewer through many light-hearted moments while educating the basic steps of IVF.

Ms Anindita Sarbadhicari

An IVF mother, shared her personal journey, offering an insightful and candid perspective on the psychological and emotional aspects of becoming a single mother through IVF. She spoke about the challenges she faced in a society that often questions the choices of women, especially regarding their decision to pursue motherhood without a partner. From facing intrusive and judgmental questions about the father's identity to societal assumptions about a woman's morality, Anindita emphasized how vital it is for women to be confident and committed to their decision to pursue IVF, regardless of outside opinions.

For her, the journey of IVF was about experiencing "the magic of creating life" within her body. Despite this success, she acknowledged that the road to motherhood was not always smooth. IVF can be emotionally taxing, and the failures along the way were tough, but she advised others to be prepared for the ups and downs of the process. She believed that the society is in a state of constant flux and with medical science progressing every day leading the Doctors to perform miracles with their advanced knowledge and skills; women have undergone a sea change in their thinking patterns.

Dr. Bhaskar Pal acknowledged the revolution IVF has caused in gynecology, transforming the experience of infertility.
